CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – LIARD STREET

April 2020

Dear Resident,

COVID-19 is an unprecedented situation and the City of Ottawa is committed to protecting our employees and our community. The City of Ottawa has reviewed the essential workplaces information provided by the Province; construction on critical infrastructure projects - including roads, bridges, sewer, water, transit and transportation - falls within the exemption. As such, at this time, the City is not suspending work on these types of projects. By Order of the Province of Ontario, all permitted construction will be allowed to take place between the hours of 6 am and 10 pm, seven days a week until October 7, 2020.

The City is working closely with the industry and complying with restrictions and recommendations provided by municipal, provincial and federal health officials, as well as the Ministry of Labour, Training and Skills Development.

The City of Ottawa will undertake the repair of approximately 14.4 metres of the storm sewer at the intersection of Liard Street and Basswood Avenue. The project team encourages the residents in this area to provide a contact email or phone number to receive timely information about the project and potential impacts. - Who:** The City of Ottawa has retained the contractor, Laurent Leblanc, to complete the work.
- Why:** The City of Ottawa will be undertaking these repairs to address localized structural damage to sewer infrastructure.
- What:** Work will involve the removal of the damaged pipe(s) and replace them with section(s) of new pipe.
- When:** This work is planned to begin **late-April 2020** and be completed in spring 2020, weather dependent.



NOTICE TO RESIDENT

Where: Construction activity to facilitate the replacement of the storm sewer will occur at the intersection of Liard Street and Basswood Avenue. Both streets will remain open to local traffic. Access to private driveways may be limited for short durations throughout the construction period, however you will be notified ahead of any such restrictions.
